





# Certificate II in Rail Infrastructure

Upon successful completion of this course you will have the foundational knowledge and skills to perform a variety of tasks in rail infrastructure, maintenance and operations, allowing you to perform the role of Track Worker, Track Maintainer or Track Installer.

### **Assessment Process:**

- Demonstrate your knowledge through face-to-face assessments conducted by industry qualified CERT assessors
- Apply your learnings with structured activities
- Undertake practical demonstrations with the guidance of industry qualified CERT Assessors

## **Delivery Method:**

• 6 weeks face-to-face, including on-site rail facility assessment activities (excluding weekends)

### Funding Eligibility Criteria:

- 15 years or over
- No longer at school
- QLD permanent resident
- An Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, New Zealand citizen or humanitarian visa holder
- Must not hold, or be enrolled into a Certificate III or higher level qualification
